[Kinkakuji Temple (Golden Pavilion)]

Kinkakuji is a Zen temple in northern Kyoto whose top two floors are completely covered in gold leaf. Kinkakuji is an impressive structure built overlooking a large pond, and is the only building left of Yoshimitsu's former retirement complex.

[Nijo Castle]

Nijo Castle was built in 1603 as the Kyoto residence of Tokugawa leyasu, the first shogun of the Edo Period (1603-1867). His grandson lemitsu completed the castle's palace buildings 23 years later and further expanded the castle by adding a five story castle keep.

[Kiyomizudera Temple]

Kiyomizudera is one of the most celebrated temples of Japan. It was founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto, and derives its name from the fall's pure waters.
